WAIT LIST INFORMATION

Field Spaniel Society of America is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial’s closing date/time. A maximum of **50 entries per trial** will be placed on the club’s wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to **Wednesday, May 24 2023 at 6 pm**. **No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing on May 24, 2023. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry.**

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website.

SMOKING IS PERMITTED ON TRIAL SITE – outside, no butts on ground.

RIBBONS, AWARDS AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....**Blue**
Second Place.....**Red**
Third Place.....**Yellow**
Fourth Place.....**White**
Qualifying Score.....**Dark Green**
A New title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

All ribbons must be claimed on the day of the trial.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Field Spaniel Society of America and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Field Spaniel Society of America has the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Field Spaniel Society of America or any official thereof.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, active of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Veterinary notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

FROM NORTH & SOUTH: US 23 N or I-75 S to Exit 117 A (I-69 East) to Exit 141 turn left (north) on Belsay Rd. Turn right on E Potter Rd. 2nd driveway on the left.

FROM EAST & WEST: From 1-69 East Bound: Take I-69 E to Belsay Rd.(exit 141). Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto Belsay Rd. Turn right onto E Potter Rd. The DDOM driveway is on the left, look for road signs and a white mailbox marked DDOM. The DDOM field is in the back of the property, follow the signs on the property to DDOM and then you will be directed where to park upon arrival. From 1-69 West Bound: Take I-69 W to Irish Rd (exit 143). Turn right onto Irish Rd. Turn left onto E Potter Rd. The DDOM driveway is on the left, look for road signs and a white mailbox marked DDOM. The DDOM field is in the back of the property, follow the signs on the property to DDOM and then you will be directed where to park upon arrival.



EXHIBITOR CHECK -IN: at check-in you will receive your armband number.

Exhibitors MUST check-in

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'Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.' Additionally, clubs should include any specific local or state health requirements: for example, proof of rabies vaccination.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial site. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Crating space will be from vehicles, bring easy ups. Small amount of crating for workers only.

Spaces for unentered dogs will not be provided at these trials, as provided in Chapter 11, Section 11 of the 'Rules Applying to Dog Shows'.

RINGSIDE. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim of loss, injury or damage to this dog.
